and respectfully represent as follows: Termination

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of May  
A. D. 1930, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in The Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Eugene C. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to From 1 - 2 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable County Attorney David Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Herbert Riley  
I was convicted under the name of Herbert Riley
