First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of January
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable D. W. Moffatt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five to Twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
