Application of SAM LYTE No.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole or pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of possession of intoxicating liquor

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of February A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to be confined in the County Jail in and for Salt Lake County, State of Utah, for a period of six months; and to pay a fine in the sum of \$299.00. and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail on the 14th day of February, 1930.
