First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of robbery without a weapon

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 21 day of September A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. C. Conkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Calvin Lawless prosecuted the case.
