First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of Dec.
A. D. 1929, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to from one to twenty
years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Samuel Gibson
I was convicted under the name of Samuel Gibson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

William VanDucwigie

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except State Land
School
