Application of Lemuel O. Gibson No. 5567

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26 day of February  
A. D. 1931, at City of Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge H. S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Lemuel Oscar Gibson

I was convicted under the name of Lemuel Gibson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except one
