Application of Jesus Arisco No. 5381

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with Deadly Weapon

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 31st day of April
A. D. 1930; at Price, Utah County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.
