Application of Evaristo Martinez

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with intent to commit Murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of January  
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge David W. Moffat presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve a term of from 1 to 20 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray VanCott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Evaristo Martinez  
I was convicted under the name of Evaristo Martinez

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows:
