I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake City
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of November
A. D. 1929, at Panguitch County of Garfield
and State of Utah, in the Sixth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Nephi J. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Salt Lake Penitentiary for a term of
6 months to 3 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison

Fourth-Honorable Olof E. Mickelsen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Justet Ellison
I was convicted under the name of W. J. Ellison

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none
