Application of Ted Stoddard

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Obt. Property by False Pretence

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of December,
A. D. 1929, at Logan, Utah County of Cache
and State of Utah, in the First Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Mr. Preston prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Telford Stoddard
I was convicted under the name of Ted Stoddard
