Application of Thomas Mitchell No. 5414

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9 day of July  
A. D. 1930, at Ogden County of Weber

and State of Utah, in Second Judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Thomas Mitchell

I was convicted under the name of Thomas Mitchell

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Rid Burr

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except this present  
one
