To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Indecent Assault  
on 4-4-30

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of April  
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in The 3<sup>rd</sup> Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge David W. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to The State Prison for a  
term not to exceed five years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail until April  
18<sup>th</sup> 1930 and was then taken to the  
State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Asst. Dist. Atty. Rawlins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Washington Gorman

I was convicted under the name of Wm. W. Gorman

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except on charges  
of disturbing the peace by fighting on  
three different occasions twice in Salt Lake  
city in the years 1911 and 1914, and once in Rupert,  
Idaho the Spring of 1928,  
I have never before been charged with a felony.
