Application of Jean Devosse

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the about the 4th day of November A. D. 1927, at Richfield County of Sevier and State of Utah, in sixth district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge W. Erickson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to twenty years (1 to 20) and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison for six and one half months, when I ran away and after having served over four years in Co. Jail and State Prison in Minn. I was then returned here where I will have served 2 years 2 mo. Sept 21.

Fourth-Honorable Nephi J. Bates prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Vernie Jean Moody

I was convicted under the name of Jean Devosse

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Robert Clark

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except burglary and larceny as shown on records. I wish to be released on condition that I leave Utah and go to Minnesota as soon as I am released.
