To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Depriving the owner of his car

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of November
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in The Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Oscar W. McCorkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 90 days to 10 years with extreme leniency
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable John D. Rice & Ray Van Gatt prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Evan LeRoy Thomas
I was convicted under the name of LeRoy Thomas

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Mr. Harold Chamberlain and Ferris Murphy

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except The State Industrial
School
