I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of November
A. D. 1930; at Farmington County of Davis
and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George S. Barlifer presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate term of five yrs.
to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Evan LeRoy Thomas
I was convicted under the name of Roy Thomas

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Depriving the
owner of his car in the year of 1929.
