I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 1st Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 24th day of April,
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Life imprisonment,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Roy E. Donnell.

I was convicted under the name of Roy E. Donnell.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Angeline Wacaster and Gilbert Brighton.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
