First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of December,  
A. D. 1929, at Manti County of San Pete  
and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Wooley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Fred V. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Harry Christiansen  
I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Ezra Hayes and Willis Larsen.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
