Application of Harry Christiansen

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of forgery, and am now on parole.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of December, A. D. 1929, at Manti County of Sanpete and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve from one to twenty years in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison until March 15th, 1930, since which time I have been on parole.

Fourth-Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Harry Christiansen I was convicted under the name of Harry Christiansen

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Willis Larsen and Ezra Hayes

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except forgery for which I was sentenced as above, and for petit larceny committed in 1928.
