Application of William Grigsby.

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of October  
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Grigsby

I was convicted under the name of William Grigsby
