Application of W. P. Grigsby No. 5263

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of October, A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William P. Grigsby

I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
