To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 day of November
A. D. 1933, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James W. Mc Kinney presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to five years to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Harley Gustin prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Bert S. Hanni
I was convicted under the name of Bert Hanni

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: G. W. Roberts and L. Hiteaman

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows
