First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th, day of September,
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable O. W. McConky presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Calvin Rawlings, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is J. B. Norton.

I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Bill Stevenson.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except The above.
