First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 30 day of August
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Moffett presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Van Batten Rollins prosecuted the case.
