Application of Jack Crow

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of March  
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar Mc. Conkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from six  
months to three years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Calvin W Rawlings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Harry Lee Royce

I was convicted under the name of Jack Crow

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as shown on prison records
