First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempt Burglary

A. D. 1930, at  Ogden  County of  Weber   
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Eugene Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An Indeterminate Term  
of from One to Ten Years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
