Application of Carl Cannon No. 5363

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison

under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carried Knowledge

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of March, A. D. 1930, at Chubb

County of Summit and State of Utah, in Second District

Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable

Jessie W. McQuinn presiding. Third-I was sentenced to Utah State Prison, returned from

1 day to life years, not to exceed five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Jessie W. McQuinn prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Henry Carl Cannon

I was convicted under the name of Carl Cannon

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

as follows: None Truly, Andrew Wilson, any myself

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none
