Application of Cecil Carson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination or Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of March
A. D. 1930, at Coalville County of Summit
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James M. McKinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term not
to exceed five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison for forty
nine days, paroled May 17, 1930. Parole
revoked July 17, 1930

Fourth-Honorable Ray Vancott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is George Cecil Carson
I was convicted under the name of Cecil Carson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Andrew Gibson and Ross Huff

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
