Application of Cecil Carson,

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination,
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison,
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th. day of March,
A. D. 1930, at Coalville, Utah, County of Summit,
and State of Utah, in Third District, Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James W. McKinney, presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One Day, To Five Years,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison, Granted A Parole
May 17th. 1930. Parole was Revoked. July 17th. 1930. There after
have been Confined in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Raymond VanCott, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is George Cecil Carson,
