Application of Cecil Carson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in on parole
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Abuse

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26 day of March
A. D. 1930, at Coalville County of Summit
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James McKinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one day to five years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison, released on
May 17 on parole, parole revoked July 17, 1930
released again on parole June 26, 1931

Fourth-Honorable Raymond Van Catta prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Cecil Carson

I was convicted under the name of Cecil Carson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Andrew Gibson and Ross Huff

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none
