Application of Hugh Cochrane

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination for Deportation, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree,

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of November, A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.
