I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the eight day of May
A. D. 1934, at Kernal County of Uintah
and State of Utah, in Second district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Martin M. Larson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one two twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dallas H. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Alfred Kidd

I was convicted under the name of Alfred Kidd

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Dallas Massey

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except eighteen
months in Utah State Prison
