and State of Utah, in 2 District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Eugene C. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 20 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.
