Application of James A. Grady No. 5320

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of January
A. D. 1930, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Eugene E. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 20 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of James A. Grady.
