Application of D. J. Jackson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of July A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable O. W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Ray VanGott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Donald James Jackson I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
