and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of July,
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Donald J. Jackson
I was convicted under the name of D. J. Jackson
