Application of W.A. Farr. No. 4176

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a commutation
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of robbery and murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of Dec.
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M.L. Richie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to life imprisonment
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable W.R. Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Arthur Farr

I was convicted under the name of W.A. Farr

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
