I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery & Murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of December,
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid; Honorable Morris L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Life imprisonment,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable W. R. Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William A. Farr,
I was convicted under the name of William A. Farr.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: W. Rex Aylett.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
