I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of June
A. D. 1928, at Manti County of San Pete
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of one to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Sheldon R. Clark
I was convicted under the name of Sheldon R. Clark

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
