Application of Sheldon R. Clark

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of June  
A. D. 1928, at Manti, Utah County of Sanpete  
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to the Utah State Prison for an indeterminate  
term, as provided by Section 8028 Compiled Laws of Utah, 1917, of not  
less than one nor more than ten years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Sheldon R. Clark
