First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in County Jail  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of stealing one sheep.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Feb 15<sup>th</sup> day of Feb.  
A. D. 1928, at North Jordan County of Salt Lake County  
and State of Utah, in S. S. Beckstead Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable S. S. Beckstead presiding.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail

Fourth-- Honorable S. S. Beckstead prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas James Crane.

I was convicted under the name of Thomas Crane.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Vic. Neumer.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this offense  
and I am sorry that it happened and it  
will never happen again if I get out  
of it this time.
