To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Embezzlement

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of January A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Groesbeck
