and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 2nd Deg.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of April
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wright presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Life - Commuted to 20 years, Sept. 1931.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Ila M. Peterson

I was convicted under the name of Ila M. Peterson
