Application of Charles Davis.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence,  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of automobile theft,

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of January, 1930  
A. D., at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Moffitt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve from one day to five years,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Prosecutor Raylins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Charles Davis.  
I was convicted under the name of Charles Davis.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Edward Briggs.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
