and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempt Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11 day of May
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable David Moffit presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an Indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John Gerald Latham
I was convicted under the name of John Latham

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Neil Edwards Edwards was given a
directed verdict of Not Guilty by Judge McConkie.
