Application of John Latham

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison,
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of May,
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Moffit presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John Latham.

I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Edw. Myers.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
