and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery And Attempt Robbery  
Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of May  
1929 Salt Lake City  
A. D. 1933 at Ogden County of Salt Lake  
Third District  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable T.H. Moffitt, E.E. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Two indeterminate terms  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray L. Van Cott, Wade Johnson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John G. Latham  
I was convicted under the name of John G. Latham
