County and State aforesaid, Honorable Eugene E. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five to life.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penetentiary.

Fourth-Honorable Wade M. Johnson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John G. Latham

I was convicted under the name of John G. Latham

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except one previous
conviction for attempted robbery.
