Application of Thomas R. Robinson, No. 4466

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Statutory

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the Sixth day of October A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable William McCrea presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Ten Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.
