First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16 day of September A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six Months To Three Years In the State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable C. W. Rawlins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Banks I was convicted under the name of James Banks

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Utah State Prison
