Application of James Banks, No. 5731.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempt burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of November A. D. 1931, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James J. Wolfe presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable A. Allen Thurman prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Banks

I was convicted under the name of James Banks

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as on record.
